Measurable Goal: The percentage of students enrolled October 1 in grades 3-4 at FAIR Pilgrim Lane School who are proficient on the MCA will increase from 34% to 44%.

Action Steps:

- K-4 small group instruction provided by the classroom teacher, educational assistants, and Reading Core tutors. (Daily)
- PLC weekly meetings review literacy data and revise literacy interventions when needed (Weekly)
- Utilizing the PLC process, identify students who are not demonstrating sufficient progress and refer the students to the MTSS team, thus strengthening the MTSS system. (Weekly)
- Grade level Data Dig Meetings twice a year. (Winter and Spring)
- Fidelity Walk-Throughs using Balanced Literacy Rubric
- Build capacity of our educational assistants to provide PRESS Intervention in all grade levels (Daily)
- Increase the number of Reading Core Tutors to five. Align reading core interventions with PRESS intervention. (Fall/winter)

Use of manipulatives to build procedural fluency, which leads to conceptual understanding.

Provide and use manipulatives in all grade levels all the time.
